### REGULATIONS

### TIME SCHEDULE

Basketball tournament will take part from May 18 to May 20, 2018.



### PLACE

Competition will be held in University of Tartu Sports Hall (Ujula 4, Tartu).

### REGISTRATION

More information about registration can be found in SELL 2018 General Regulations.

### PARTICIPANTS

All competing participants must meet the requirements of the SELL 2018 General Regulations.

There will be men's (max 20 teams) and women's (max 12 teams) tournament. The team will consist of up to 12 players and 2 coaches.

### SYSTEM OF COMPETITION

The tournament system, draw and time table will be published after the registration.

The competition will be held according to the international (FIBA) rules with the following modifications:

- The game shall consist of four (4) periods of eight (8) minutes. There shall be intervals of play of one (1) minutes between the first and second period (first half), between the third and fourth period (second half) and before extra period. There shall be a half-time interval of play of five (5) minutes.
- The clock will be stopped for the free-throws and time-outs.
- The principle of uninterrupted time does not apply during the last (1) minute of the first, second and third period and last two (2) minutes of the fourth period and the extra period and the clock is stopped every time the referee interrupts the game.
- If the score is tied at the end of playing time for the fourth period, the game shall continue with as many extra periods of two (2) minutes as is necessary to break the tie.
- Two (2) charged time-out may be granted to each team at any time during the first half; two (2) at any time during the second half and one (1) at any time during extra period. Each time-out shall last 30 seconds.
- A team is in a team foul penalty situation when it has committed four (4) team fouls in a period.
- Final and 3rd place game. Play time is 4 x 8 minutes, "interrupted time"

The tournament is played in groups. Number of groups is four (4). The two (2) best teams from all groups get into play-off and get the opportunity to play to places 1 to 8. The teams who cannot take part in play-off games get the opportunity to play to places 9 to 20.

All protests are resolved according to SELL 2018 General Regulations.
